Jude, or Thaddeus ("Courageous"), died 1st century; may have preached in Palestine & Persia; mentioned in the Roman Canon; patron of those in despair, or in hopeless situations (perhaps because of the similarity of his name with Judas Iscariot, who betrayed Jesus & despaired.) BEATIFICATION OF FR. MCGIVNEY: The Knights of Columbus announce the beatification of their founder, Venerable Fr. Michael J. McGivney on Oct. 31 in the Archdiocese of Hartford. Fr. McGivney's beatification is a cause for rejoicing throughout the world, but especially in the United States. A devoted parish priest of the Archdiocese of Hartford, Fr. McGivney founded the Knights of Columbus 138 years ago in order to serve the spiritual & material needs of Catholic men & their families. "Fr. McGivney was ahead of his time in enhancing the laity's role in the Church & inspiring the laity to put their faith into action in countless ways," Supreme Knight Carl A. Anderson said. "Today, his spirit continues to shape the extraordinary charitable work of Knights as they continue to serve those on the margins of society as he served widows and orphans in the 1880s." Presently, he is a Venerable Servant of God, a title bestowed on March 15, 2008 by Pope Benedict XVI. The cause has now entered a new & exciting phase, with a 2nd confirmed miracle through the intercession of Fr. McGivney needed for canonization & sainthood.
