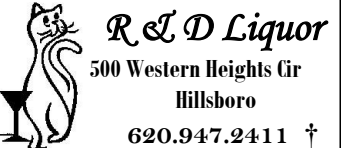
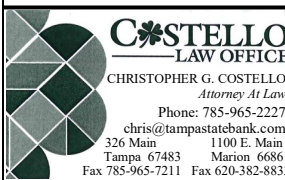
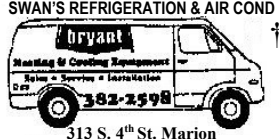

Feast days for week of Jan. 15th: Mon., Weekday Tues., **St. Anthony, abbot:** Anthony, or Antony, died 356 at age 105; born in upper Egypt; hermit & early founder of religious life; called the “Patriarch of Monks”; aided St. Athanasius of Alexandria in combating Arianism. **Wed., Weekday** Thurs., **Weekday** Fri., **St. Fabian, pope, martyr; St. Sebastian, martyr:** Fabian, died 250 under Decius; layman elected bishop of Rome in 236; his body came to be transferred from the catacombs of Callistus to the basilica of St. Sebastian. Sebastian, died 288 at Rome under Diocletian; chief of the Praetorian cohort whose *acta* tells of his being pierced by arrows, later being clubbed to death; patron of archers, soldiers, & police associations. **Sat., St. Agnes, virgin, martyr:** Agnes, died beginning of 4th c. under Diocletian at the age of 12; patroness of Christian virtue confronted by political & social violence; represented with a martyr's palm & a lamb (her name in Latin is lamb); the wool from 2 lambs blessed to-day will be used to make the pallia which will be blessed by the Pope on June 29; mentioned in the Roman Canon.

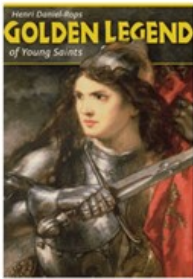

Call me if there is an emergency. Call me if there is an urgent difficulty in the family. Call me if there is a spontaneous get-together. Call me if there is an unexpected project in the field or at work and you’re willing to let me lend a hand. But make sure you call—my phone does not get texts. Everything else (questions, future plans, scheduling a meeting), let’s talk in person. Or just call or email the church office.
If it is an emergency, call twice back-to-back. If that doesn’t work, have Rose call me twice—her ringtone is different on my phone, so I’ll know it’s urgent. (I’m open to Rose-ringtonesuggestions: *Crazy Train, Welcome to the Jungle?*)
Lastly, I’m struck by yall’s desire to do things together, your willingness to act—it’s inspiring. I ask that you give me some time to get to know you and our parish before I make definitive decisions. Through Jesus, with him, and in him, approach the Father and ask Emil to teach me how to fearlessly offer my life as the servant of you all, who are servants. Ask Joseph to help me be strong and gentle like a father. Ask Mary to share with me her poverty, so that I can be surprised, every day, by the concrete presence of the Risen One.
