Feast days for week of May 7th: Mon., Easter Weekday Tues., Easter Weekday Wed., St. John of Avila, priest, Doctor of the Church; St. Damien de Veuster, priest: John of Avila, 1499-1569, a Spanish priest, preacher, scholastic author, & religious mystic. Called the "Apostle of Andulasia" for his extensive ministry in that region of Spain; patron of Andulasia & Spanish secular clergy. Damian de Veuster, died 1889 at age 49; Belgian who joined the Fathers of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary; arrived in Honolulu 1864; in 1873 began his work on Moloka'i, known as "Devil's Island," used as a colony for over 800 lepers; diagnosed with leprosy in 1885; a man of intense interior life & deep simplicity; canonized Oct. 11, 2009; "I make myself a leper with the lepers, to gain all for Jesus Christ."
Thurs., Easter Weekday Fri., Sts. Nereus & Achilleus, martyrs; St. Pancras, martyr: Nereus & Achilleus, died end of 1st century; Praetorian soldiers who converted to Christianity; beheaded during the reign of Trajan. Pancras, died c. 304; orphan who came to Rome where he was converted to Christianity; beheaded under Diocletian in his 14th year. **Sat., Our Lady of Fatima:** Our Lady of Fatima appeared to 3 shepherd children in Portugal in 1917. Message of Fatima - call to conversion of heart, repentance from sin, & prayer, especially the Rosary. **6th Sunday of Easter:** Acts 8:5-8, 14-17 1 Pt 3:15-18 Jn 14:15-21
