POPE FRANCIS TWEETS: Today begins the month

of October, the month of the Rosary and of the missions. I encourage everyone to experience the beauty of praying the Rosary, contemplating the mysteries of Christ with Mary and invoking her intercession for the needs of the Church and of the world.

To my parish family:

I want to be with you. (Jn17:24)

If I am not in the office,

I am with you.

If I am with you,

I am not on the phone.

I am with you.

If I am not in the office,

and I am not with you,

then I try to not be on the phone.

I need to be with Him, the Silence.

As a reminder, face-to-face is the best way to be with each other, to talk, or, to set up a time and place to talk and be with each other more. I'll have my calendar with me after our celebrations of the Eucharist. Wait a moment, and let's talk then, in person.

If waiting to be in person is too inconvenient, please call or email Rose at the church office, or just stop by and see her. Rose is a joy and helps all of us greatly. As my assistant, she will help you with your questions, or help you schedule a time and place for you and I to be together. I thank the Father for her and her service to us.

If a loved one is dying, let's celebrate the Sacred Mysteries of Reconciliation, Anointing with the Apostolic Pardon, and Viaticum, possibly even within a Mass at his or her home. Schedule this celebration and good preparation for death while your loved one is still conscious and able to participate and prepare well for the journey. Of course, unplanned accidents may happen. Please call my personal cellphone immediately and leave a voicemail-message with details of where your loved one is. I greatly desire to be there with him or her and you all, and to celebrate as many of the sacraments as possi-

ble (only Anointing of the Sick if he or she is unconscious). My personal cellphone number is 316.650.3260. I use it as an old answering machine. It does not receive text messages.

Intense family/personal difficulties may happen. Again, I desire to be with you in that suffering. Call my cellphone and leave a message. Spontaneous gatherings happen too! If you'll have me, leave a voicemail on my cell phone.
