CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

You should have received your appeal packets in the mail. If not, please contact the office.

Pledges go straight to the diocese for the *One Family Fully Alive in Christ!* campaign. All gifts will be used only for campaign case statement, ie: Catholic School teacher salary enhancements, Cathedral domes and window restoration, individual parish needs, purchase and redevelopment of a Catholic family and youth camp, and serving those in need through the *In Love of God and Neighbor Fund*.

Suggested pledge amounts are based off a family's past giving history. Pledges should not impact regular parish tithing.

To fill out your pledge card:

1. Prayerfully determine how much you can pledge.
2. Decide if you want to give a one-time pledge or if you'd like to break it down monthly, quarterly, etc. Amounts would be payable over 3 years, unless it's a one-time gift.
3. Mark down the date (month/day/year) you'd like to start your commitment.
4. Sign, date, and fill out additional contact info.
5. Place pledge card in envelope and mail to the Catholic Diocese of Wichita.

No money needs to be sent now. You will be contacted *by the diocese* when your chosen time for payment is due.
