### STEWARDSHIP IS A FAITH RESPONSE

*a Stewardship reflection by Fr. Jarrod Lies*

"Beloved, if God so loved us, we also must love one another" (1 Jn 4:11). The wellspring of stewardship is this: "God is love" (1 Jn 4:8). **The love in which stewardship is exercised is agapē—self-sacrificial love.** It imitates the self-emptying, self-donating love of Jesus, who loved us to the end (Jn 13:1). This love is not merely an example placed before us; it is a gift poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit (Rom 5:5). Our response is twofold: we dwell in love, and we share that love. Such love becomes visible in prayer, hospitality. Thus John warns, "If someone who has worldly means sees a brother in need and refuses him compassion, how can the love of God remain in him?" (1 Jn 3:17).
