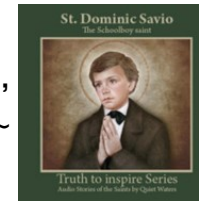

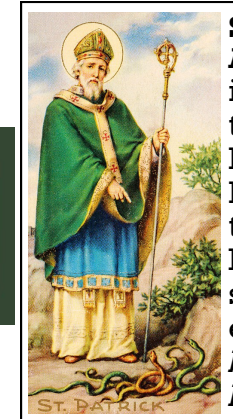

LENT MEAL & BIBLE STUDY WITH STATIONS OF THE CROSS: The Monday night Bible Study has moved to Friday after Stations during Lent only. AND—There will be a Lenten Meal on Fridays during Lent at 6pm at MAC. There will be weekly signups for attendance so there is enough food. Stations of the Cross will be held after the meal at 7pm followed by a Lenten Bible Study from 7:30-8:30 with child care provided [sign-up required] for those taking the class.

LENTEN BIBLE STUDY: Why do we suffer so much in this life? What is the purpose and meaning of our trials? How can we find hope and healing amidst our sorrow? Dr. Bob Schuchts, Founder and President of the John Paul II Healing Center, seeks to answer these difficult questions in a new 4-part series by Saint Benedict Press: *Real Suffering: Finding Hope and Healing in the Trials of Life*. Suffering is something that touches everyone from the poor to the powerful. It can lead to doubts about God's love, and can leave hearts unhappy for a lifetime. But it doesn't have to be this way. What if suffering was the catalyst to our union with Christ? Drawing on decades of experience as a Marriage and Family Therapist, as well as on his own personal crosses, Dr. Schuchts expertly and compassionately examines the complex nature of human suffering. Dissecting the three basic categories of human trial—physical pain, emotional loss, and spiritual guilt—he shows the underlying purpose of our sorrows and helps us to see how, if we bear our crosses with faith, they can be a means for us to draw closer to God. **The class will be offered at Marion after Friday Stations, and at Pilsen on Tuesdays, see sidebar.** The class can also be taken at home using the books and accessing the class videos online at any time. **Contact the office for materials & to sign up for child care.**
